This bar pendant has 7 ball pendants of varying sizes attached in clear, amber, smokey, and light blue colours. All the wires are adjustable so you can create your own look by adjusting the lengths of each pendant as you like.

The Adriatic teal / blue coloured, coned-shaped glass pendant (code: 24786) retails for R1099,00 from The Lighting Warehouse.

The Aegean teal / blue , cylinder glass pendant (code: 24781) retails for R1099,00 from The Lighting Warehouse.

The teal / blue Curacao (code: 24784), and the **clear Highland** (code: 24785) conical glass pendant lights both retail for R1099,00 each from The Lighting Warehouse.

The teal / blue Andaman (code: 24783), and the **clear Speyside** (code: 24782) oval glass pendant lights both retail for R1099,00 from The Lighting Warehouse.

Melissa says that the incandescent carbon filament, pear-shaped, dimmable globe (code: 21109, Retail price: R99,00) and the LED filament, pear-shaped, dimmable globe (code: 8944, Price: R149,00 are ideal complements to the teal and clear pendants. She recommends the E14 LED Golfball globes (code: 5635, Price: R39,00) for the Travolta Multi bar pendant fixture.
